Public Transport

Train

South Bank has two train stations, both conveniently located on Grey Street, South Bank. Trains run regularly from the South Bank and South Brisbane Stations.

Bus

South Bank is connected to Brisbane's Busway with buses departing regularly from South Bank and Cultural Centre Stations.

South Brisbane Loop

The South Brisbane Loop, Route 86 bus service commences on Monday 23 January for a 12-month trial period. This is a free bus service operating every 10-15 minutes, 7 days a week between 10am – 11pm traveling in an anti-clockwise direction along Grey Street, Montague Road, Vulture Street and Tribune Street.

The buses are branded green and white with two South Bank stops on Grey Street – outside South Bank Cinema and South Brisbane train station. For more information on the service visit the <u>Brisbane City Council website</u> and the <u>Translink website</u> for a detailed timetable.

CityCat & Ferries

CityCats operate every day and stop at the South Bank Terminal on the Clem Jones Promenade. The inner-city City Hopper ferry travels between the North Quay, CBD at Riverside, Kangaroo Point and Sydney Street, New Farm, stopping at South Bank Terminal on the Clem Jones Promenade.

Car Parking

South Bank Parklands parking

South Bank's underground car park offers more than 800 spaces (including eight disabled bays) with stair and lift accessibility from both its north and south entrances. The car park is located at Little Stanley Street, South Bank with entry via Tribune or Glenelg Street and a height restriction of 2.1m. For traffic flow, please pay at the pay stations (located at the lifts and main stairwells) before returning to your car. If required, you can also pay via credit card at the gates upon exiting.

South Bank car park prices are shown on the <u>eatSouthBank website</u>. This car park also has an online parking portal where you can book your space in advance and access online-only specials via the <u>eatSouthBank website</u>.

Please note that all on-street parking at South Bank precinct is managed by Brisbane City Council. For more information about on-street parking visit the <u>Council website</u> or call: 07 3403 8888.
