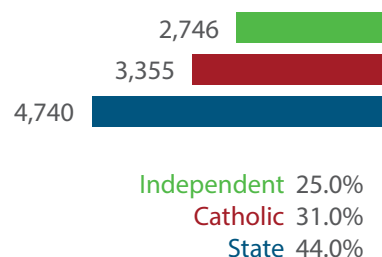

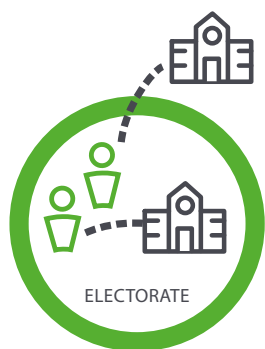

STUDENT PARTICIPATION RATES²

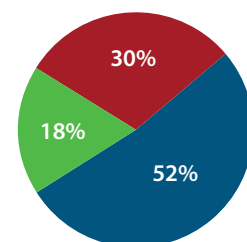
