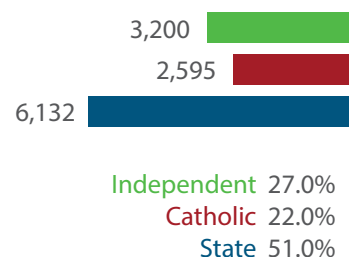

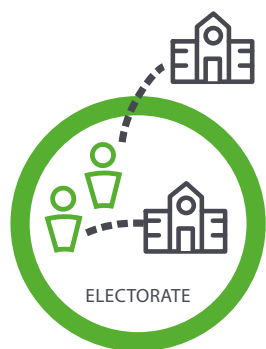

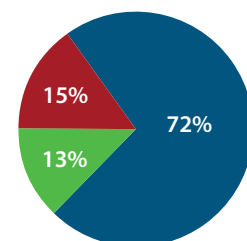
STUDENT PARTICIPATION RATES²
